



ATTENTION RESIDENTS, BUSINESSES, AND GENERAL PUBLIC

In an effort to reduce the spread of the Coronavirus in the City of Center Line and the Metro-Detroit region; and due to the recent declaration of emergency by the Governor, and actions taken by Macomb County and other local governments, the City of Center Line is issuing the following response.

The City of Center Line will close the Memorial Park Recreation Center and Public Library beginning Monday, March 16, 2020 through the end of March. All essential services can be provided by those departments by calling the City of Center Line City Hall at 586-757-6800. All events, activities and facility rentals are cancelled during this time. Full refunds will be issued.

The City Hall will remain open during this time for essential services only. We asked that the public call the City Hall at 586-757-6800 before going to the city hall for a service. If the service can not be provided by use of FAX, email, city web site, or social media, then the public will be allowed to come to the city hall, but only for essential services.

Inspections for non-owner occupied properties, building, plumbing, and electrical will not occur during this time. Please call the city hall at 586-757-6800 to reschedule your appointments for inspections. There will be no Ordinance Enforcement during this time.

Water shut-off will not occur during this period, but the city does encourage the public to pay their past due water bills as quickly as possible, as the shut-offs will occur shortly after this emergency response ends. Trash and branch pick up will remain on schedule.

DPW essential services will continue. Water main breaks and other essential repairs will be addressed. Water meter replacements will not occur during this time. If you are scheduled for a water meter replacement, the city will contact you to reschedule the work.

Public Safety emergency services will continue. Non-essential services such as complaints, reports and statements can be done by calling the Public Safety at 586-757-2200. Please avoid coming into the Public Safety unless absolutely necessary.

The City of Center Line respectfully requests that the public not go to the Municipal Complex unless they absolutely need to. If you recently traveled by boat, bus, train or plane, either domestically or internationally, or you are ill, please do not go to any public buildings. If you have an emergency, that requires public assistance, please call 911 or 586-757-2200.

Finally, be smart, wash your hands often or use hand sanitizer after each contact with another person; avoid handshakes; cough or sneeze into your upper sleeve; keep your hands away from your eyes, mouth and nose; and if you are sick, stay home.

The City of Center Line is hoping that this response to the Coronavirus will help keep the virus from spreading in our community. The public's assistance towards that goal is appreciated.
