

**SPORTS EQUIPMENT IN RIGHT-OF-WAY PROHIBITED
ORDINANCE 408**

Prohibited Conduct

No person or persons shall place in any public street, right-of-way or on any sidewalk of any public street, any fixed or portable basketball net, backboard or other equipment or apparatus for the playing of basketball or any other sport for which such an apparatus can be used.

Enforcement and Confiscation

Any person violating the above provision shall be subject to a warning for the first violation, a fine of \$100.00 for the second and a fine not to exceed \$250.00 for each subsequent violation; and after a second violation, the sports equipment shall be confiscated by the Department of Public Safety and impounded.

Storage and Disposal

The impounded equipment will be stored for a maximum of 30 days to allow the owner the opportunity to claim the property. The equipment may be claimed during regular business hours and will be released upon payment of a \$100.00 confiscation and storage fee. If the equipment is not claimed within the 30-day time period, it shall be disposed of in an appropriate manner.
