

AMENDMENTS TO OFFENSES ON SCHOOL PROPERTY ORDINANCES
(Article IX, Sections 46-336 through 46-344)Approved 10.01.2018

Sec. 46-336. – Defacing or damaging school buildings.

No person shall mark, deface or damage any building owned, occupied or otherwise used as a school within the city.

Any violation of this ordinance is a misdemeanor, punishable upon conviction thereof as provided in section 1-13 of this Code.

Sec. 46-337. – Defacing or damaging fixtures.

No person shall mark, deface or damage any fence, tree, lawn or other fixture situated on property owned, occupied or otherwise used by a school within the city.

Any violation of this ordinance is a misdemeanor, punishable upon conviction thereof as provided in section 1-13 of this Code.

Sec. 46338. – Disturbing peace or school session.

No person shall make, or assist in the making of any noise or diversion which disturbs or tends to disturb the peace, quiet or good order of such school or class in session within the city.

A violation of this section is a civil infraction which is punishable by a fine not exceeding one-hundred dollars (\$100.00), plus costs and other sanctions for each violation.

Sec. 46-339. – Disturbing gatherings or functions.

No person shall make, or assist in the making of any noise or diversion which disturbs or tends to disturb the peace, quiet or good order of any gathering or function held at any building or property owned, occupied or used by a school within the city.

A violation of this section is a civil infraction which is punishable by a fine not exceeding one-hundred dollars (\$100.00), plus costs and other sanctions for each violation.

Sec. 46-340. – Fighting on school property.

No person shall engage, participate, or otherwise be involved in any fight or other physical confrontation with another while in any school building or property owned, occupied or otherwise used by a school within the city.

A violation of this section is a civil infraction which is punishable by a fine not exceeding one-hundred dollars (\$100.00), plus costs and other sanctions for each violation.

Sec. 46-341. – Alcoholic liquors prohibited.

No person shall consume, or be in possession, of any alcoholic liquors while in any school building or property owned, occupied or otherwise used by a school within the city.

Any violation of this ordinance is a misdemeanor, punishable upon conviction thereof as provided in section 1-13 of this Code.

Sec. 46-342. – Tobacco products prohibited.

- (a) No person shall use any tobacco product while in any building owned, occupied or otherwise used by a school, or while on any property owned, occupied or otherwise used by a school except as otherwise provided.
- (b) “Tobacco product” is defined as a preparation of tobacco to be inhaled, chewed or placed in a person’s mouth, including, but not limited to, cigars, cigarettes, pipes and chewing tobacco.
- (c) Subsection (a) shall not apply to persons age 18 or older on outdoor areas owned, used or otherwise occupied by a school, including, but not limited to, an open-air stadium, during either of the following time periods:
 - 1. Saturdays, Sundays, and other days on which there are no regularly scheduled school hours;
 - 2. After 6:00 p.m. on days during which there are regularly scheduled school hours.

A violation of this section is a civil infraction which is punishable by a fine not exceeding one-hundred dollars (\$100.00), plus costs and other sanctions for each violation.

Sec. 46-343. – Permission of principal for presence on school premises.

It shall be unlawful for any person not a student or employee of any school located in the city to remain within any school during normal school hours, or on any property owned, occupied or otherwise used by any school within the city, without reporting directly to the main office of the school and securing written permission of the principal or person in charge of the school.

A violation of this section is a civil infraction which is punishable by a fine not exceeding one-hundred dollars (\$100.00), plus costs and other sanctions for each violation.

Sec. 46-344. – Hours grounds and buildings closed to public; exception.

It shall be unlawful for any person to loiter or remain upon any school grounds or in any school building between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. This article does not apply to employees of the school, or during the conduct of any activity under the direction, supervision or permission of the school.

A violation of this section is a civil infraction which is punishable by a fine not exceeding one-hundred dollars (\$100.00), plus costs and other sanctions for each violation.
